## Project "Integrated Organic Farming" in Gombak, Malaysia



- Established relation with indigenous people
- Empowered 13 communities with 470+ people
- Collected 9,845 kg of food waste



# Project "U-Farmer" in Purwakarta, Indonesia



- Conducted an Urban Farming Expo
- Reached 650,000+ people online
- Created 6 new demo plots
- Built an Urban Farming
   Training Centre
- Trained 1,500 urban farmers



## Project "Digital-based Farming and Agripreneurship" in Polewali, Indonesia



- Developed four prototypes of digital farming tools to support cocoa processing
- Created a digital marketing platform to open more expansive access to markets
- Involved 50 young cocoa farmers



#### Project "Nurture Nature: Eco-Farmer" in Sarawak, Malaysia



- Recruited nine farmers to adopt sustainable farming
- Established Sustainable
   Farming Educational Hub
- Ran trainings on insect composting, biological control, ayam kampung, and aquaponics
